## Part II: Narrative Explanation

### II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

This bill relates to refining victim's rights in all cases, not just felony and domestic violence cases.

This engrossed bill makes the following changes:

#### Section 1(1)

The language adds that victim rights apply in any adult or juvenile criminal proceeding and any civil commitment proceeding under 71.09.

#### Section 1(1)(h)

Civil commitment process added to this section.

#### Section 1(l)

Language added with respect to victims in addition to felony cases, that victims of any case involving DV, or any final determination under 71.09 (civil commitment) are to be informed of trial and hearings.

#### Section 1(n)

Any case involving domestic violence language restored in engrossed bill.

#### Section 1 (2)

Added to provide if applicable victim, survivor of a victim, or witness of crime is denied a right under this section, the person may seek an order directing compliance in superior court where the crime occurred. The court shall expedite consideration of this petition.
