The bill would amend Chapter 3.34 RCW establishing a minimum number of elected district court judges for each county. It would allow the county legislative authority to increase the number of judges on recommendation from the Supreme Court.

However, the bill is permissive, giving the local legislative authority the ability to increase the number of judges without authority of the Legislature.
