The amendment adds an additional prosecutor and trial-level criminal defense attorney to the task force. It provides that one prosecutor member shall represent those practicing in courts of limited jurisdiction and one prosecutor shall represent those practicing in superior courts. It also provides that one trial-level criminal defense attorney member shall represent those practicing in courts of limited jurisdiction and one trial-level criminal defense attorney member shall represent those practicing in superior courts.
