Part II: Narrative Explanation

II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

This bill allows for the usage of automated vehicle noise detectors (AVNDs) in specified vehicle-racing camera enforcement zones.

Section 1 is amended to include the usage of AVNDs.

Section 2 is a new section added to chapter 46.63 describing how the AVNDs can be used.

Section 3 is amended to specify that AVNDs can only be used to "...record audio of the vehicle immediately before, during, and after a violation". It is also amended to provide AVNDs in Sub Section 9 to allow for notices of infractions to be sent out for violations found utilizing AVND's.

II. C - Expenditures

The impact of this bill is Indeterminate, as there is no way to determine how many cities would implement these cameras if the bill is passed.

ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS:

This bill would in FY26 create a one-time cost of \$3,500 for updating publications.

This bill would also potentially incur costs up to \$340,800 in staff costs in the implementation of these cameras. This is based upon the following assumptions.

- 1. Court Staff would need to spend 15hrs working with each city that implements these cameras.
- 2. There are 281 Cites/Towns in the State of Washington.
- 3. 15hrs x 281 Cities = 4200 staff hours (FTE is equal to 2080 staff hours)
- 4. 2.0 FTEs of a Court Program Analyst to do this work.

AOC STAFF IMPACTS INCLUDE STANDARD COSTS

Salary estimates are current biennium actual rates at Step L.

Benefits are the agency average of 30.59% of salaries.

Goods and Services are the agency average of \$3,600 per direct program FTE.

Travel is the agency average of \$2,000 per direct program FTE.

Ongoing Equipment is the agency average of \$1,800 per direct program FTE.

One-time IT Equipment is \$4,800 for the first fiscal year per direct program FTE.

Agency Indirect is calculated at a rate of 25.86% of direct program salaries and benefits.
