Part II: Narrative Explanation

II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

This bill allows "a local authority" to designate nonarterial highway to be a shared street, if they have developed procedures for establishing a shared street. Requires vehicles to yield the right-of-way to pedestrians, bicyclists, operators of micromobility devices on a shared street. Defines micromobility devise (nonmotorized scooters, electric personal assistive mobility devices) and shared street.

Section 2 exempts shared streets from requirements that pedestrians use sidewalks where provided.

Section 3 sets a maximum speed limit of 10 mph on shared streets and makes current traffic penalties not applicable to shared streets.
