The bill calls for students under the age of 17 with 15 unexcused absences to enter into an agreement with the child and parent to establish school attendance requirements and to be referred to the community engagement board to establish school attendance requirements.

The bill also establishes that Juvenile courts to coordinate, to the extent possible, actions pertaining to students who have been referred to the community engagement boards under RCW 28A.225.015(3) or 28A.225.030(2) with proceedings and actions pertaining to children and youth who are the subject of at-risk youth petitions under RCW 13.32A.191 or child in need of services petitions under RCW 13.32A.140.
