II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

Amends the definition of a firearms dealer to not include any person or business who have sold 10 or fewer firearms within a 12 month period.

Section 3 amends the application process for firearms dealers. Firearms dealers will be required to go through state and federal fingerprint and background checks. Any person who has had their license revoked under this section for reasons other than an incomplete or incorrect application will not qualify for a license. Finally, A dealer who knows or should know that an employee of theirs is involved in a theft shall report the theft within 48 hours.
