Section 3 adds a new section to 9.94A that allows for individuals who committed offenses as minors and are serving a term of total confinement to petition the court for resentencing. Those who qualify for this are defined in subsections A-H. In allowing these individuals to petition the court this would cause impact to the courts as this would increase caseloads, require management of petitions from Judicial Offices and Court Staff, and increased resentencing hearings.
