II. A - Brief Description Of What The Measure Does That Has Fiscal Impact on the Courts

Section 1 and 2 amend the funding and service responsibilities for public defense services. Beginning in fiscal year 2027, county money appropriated for public defense services will be distributed pro-rata based on the number of cases filed in court's jurisdictions for which a public defender was assigned (This is determined by the annual report Under Section 5 AOC responsibility). Section 4 requires the Office of Public Defense to make recommendations regarding public defense caseloads and backlogs. Section 5 requires AOC to collect data detailing the number of cases assigned a public defender and to include that data in its annual report to the courts of Washington.
