Section 2 adds new definitions to be applied to this legislation.

Section 3 and 4 creates a new Gross misdemeanor of within disorderly conduct if a person approaches within 8 feet of another with the intent to harass, threaten or intimidate that person because of a belief or perception regarding their race, color ethnicity within a 50 feet radius of a house of worship; intentionally physically obstructs or blocks another person from entering a house of worship; intentionally damages or destroys the premises of a physical house of worship.

Section 5 prescribes the penalties.
