# **Agency Request Legislation**



- <u>SHB 1144</u>: Adding an additional superior court judge in Skagit county (Lekanoff)
  - Did not make it out of the House. We are waiting for an update from the prime sponsor and House leadership to see if this bill will be NTIB.
- <u>2SHB 1174</u>: Concerning court interpreters (Peterson)
  - Passed out of the House (66-31-1)
- <u>HB 1510</u>: Including appellate commissioners in the PERS Judicial Benefit Multiplier Program (Hill)
  - Did not make it out of Appropriations
- <u>SSB 5133</u>: Concerning departures from the guidelines for caregiver status (C. Wilson)
  - Did not make it out of the Senate
- Judicial Officer Personal Information Confidentiality
  - Did not bring bill. Worked with the SOS and their Address Confidentiality Program Manager to clarify and amend the application process for judicial officers.

- Additional Superior Court Judge(s):
  - Skagit county (SHB 1144)
  - Cowlitz county
  - Yakima county
  - Asotin, Columbia, & Garfield counties
- Adding appellate commissioners to the PERS Judicial Benefit Multiplier Program (HB 1510)
- Adding caregiver status as a mitigating factor for exceptional sentences (SSB 5133)
- Court security COA Bailiffs
- Other bills that did not pass this session but that have a potentially significant impact on the judiciary
