AOC Request Legislation Update



- **HB 1023** – Eliminating Wiretap Authorization Reporting Requirements
 - Prime Sponsor: Representative Walen
 - 3/8- Passed out of the House (90-5-3)

- **HB 1102** – Concerning pro tem compensation
 - Prime Sponsor: Representative Taylor
 - 3/9- Executive session in Senate Law & Justice

What's New (2023)?

AOC Request Legislation Update (Continued...)



- **SB 5003** – Additional district court judge for Snohomish County
 - Prime Sponsor: Senator Lovick
 - 3/10- Executive Session in House Civil Rights & Judiciary

- **SSB 5128** – Concerning jury diversity
 - Prime Sponsor: Senator Trudeau
 - 3/3- Passed out of Senate (40-9-0)

- Board for Judicial Administration (BJA) will start soliciting proposals for the 2024 legislative session late April.
- Proposals will be due in June.
