Additional Details and Requirements for all Classes

To be eligible for these classes you must:

- Be a Washington State resident.
- Have the Court Interpreter Written Exam
- Have completed the Washington State Online Orientation or attended the in-person Orientation.
- Intend to take the certified oral exam, which is currently available in the following languages: Arabic, Bosnian/Croatian/Serbian, Cantonese, French, Khmer (Cambodian), Korean, Mandarin, Portuguese, Russian, Spanish, Tagalog/Filipino, Vietnamese Please note that you are not required to take the oral exam this year.

Cost: Each class will be \$40

Space: To ensure the everyone has the opportunity to take part fully in the class, space will be limited.

What you will do in the class:

- Perform technique exercises to build foundational skills in the modes of sight translation and consecutive and simultaneous interpretation
- Sight translate and consecutively and simultaneously interpret realistic court interpreting exercises
- Discuss your performance with your instructor and fellow participants
- Brainstorm renditions for challenging terminology
- Organize and practice relevant terminology

- Approximately 6.5 hours per week to perform, perfect and study course exercises
