WHEREAS, in response to the COVID-19 emergency, this Court issued a series of general orders to ensure continued operations of the courts while protecting the health and safety of court personnel, litigants, and the public; and

WHEREAS, courts are now equipped to manage operations without reliance on the COVID-19 general orders issued by this Court, due to the public health emergency subsiding and to rule changes allowing for more remote proceedings;
