My concern is that although the school has them as guardian, there may be no legal paperwork which indicates for our purposes that they are a guardian - perhaps that is nothing to be concerned with as far as these truancy matters are concerned.

Hi Susie,

I have researched this issue with our maintenance team. Currently the GDN cannot be added in TRU cause codes for case type 7 in JIS (or any other case type 7 cause codes for that matter). However, they can be added in SCOMIS. I remember that this was an issue when I worked in the courts as well, and the only way we could enter them was as a PAR since the school is entered as the PET. When truancy cases were first introduced in superior court we added the case in SCOMIS only. Eventually it became a requirement to initiate the case add in JIS before verifying it in SCOMIS. I can only advise you to enter the GDN as a PAR in JIS for now, but will send this on as a request to the Codes Committee to add GDN as a party for case type 7 cause codes in JIS.

Valid JIS Participant Types
FHM, PAR, TRU, PYE, PYR, PRB, PET, RSP

Note:

In Truancy cases (Cause = TRU), the PET may be an SD (school district) or ED (Educational Institution) type of "person" in JIS. RSP must be an IN-type of person and should be the juvenile.
