I am submitting this comment in opposition to the proposed amendment to Rule 1.15(A)(e) of the Rules of Professional Conduct.

I am opposed to the rule change because I believe it short-changes the public and sends the message that the Bar is more intent on protecting its members than the public. I do not understand how an attorney holding property of a client would be hard-pressed to give an annual written accounting of property it holds for a client unless the attorney is sufficiently disorganized that they are not adequately equipped to hold and track property over which they take possession. This is true, from my perspective, whether the matter being held consists of original documents or other types of property.

Please do not adopt this rule change.
