Dear Ms. Faulk,

I strongly support the change of RPC 1.15A (Safeguarding Clients' Property) to cover only client funds held by a lawyer, and not to cover original documents held by a lawyer. It is a useful service to clients when attorneys hold original executed documents in safekeeping; the documents are much less likely to be lost or tampered with. Having to report annually to clients about original documents held by a lawyer would be extremely burdensome to attorneys, especially sole practitioners. I agree that any benefits resulting from annual reporting about original documents would be greatly outweighed by the burdens on attorneys.
