I oppose this proposed Rule as phrased. As written, it does not allow use of standard sized surveys and plats as exhibits to summary judgment applications. Many plat documents and surveys contain notations on their face which are unreadable when the entire document is reduced to a standard 8x11 format. Summary judgment and real estate are an integral part of my practice. It will hamper my ability to 'make a record' if appellate review is sought which includes documents that are essential to the Court's ruling, yet unreadable because the legible version is not a part of the 'official record', ie.
