I support the increased educational requirements, primarily because of public image considerations, but I would not support current CPGs being made subject to the increased requirements. Nonetheless, I think there might be merit to having a waiver option so that applicants who are outstandingly qualified in every other way could apply for an exemption or, perhaps, for a limited admission to practice that would allow them to practice concurrently working to gradually achieve the required education level.
