Dear Justice Johnson:

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on Mr. Bamburger's suggested amendments to GR 34.

The Clerks' Association does not support this proposed version and respectfully requests that the Rules Committee not approve it. The proposed language reflects a broad attempt to over-ride legislation by court rule. The legislative branch has purview over fees and has set in law the authority of judges to waive fees in certain circumstances. See RCW 36.18.022¹. Mr. Bamburger's suggested amendments inappropriately attempt to expand that authority.

There are other issues with the underlying version of GR 34 that should be addressed by the Rules Committee. Please see the Clerks' previous comments and proposed modifications of this rule, attached.
