I am an attorney in Seattle, Washington and handle serious felonies, such a first and second degree murder and civil litigation.

I am licensed in Washington, Ohio and West Virginia and federal courts in five states. I also practice in various tribal courts.

I have practiced law for more than 40 years.

Because of the serious nature of the cases I handle accurately recorded interviews are essential. Most senior prosecuting attorneys I work with encourage recording because they will received the same benefit, an accurate record of the questions and answers.

In the last year three senior deputy prosecuting attorneys in two first degree murder cases and one rape life imprisonment cases all joined with me in encouraging witnesses to consent to tape recorded interviews.

Recorded interviews are efficient use of time of the attorneys and witnesses and provide a nervous witness with a transcript to review ahead of trial testimony. I urge you to pass CrR 4.11.
