To: Office Receptionist, Clerk:

The adoption of CR 80, which currently reads "Except as otherwise ordered by the court the minimum qualification to become an authorized transcriptionist in order to complete and file an official certified court transcript from electronically recorded proceedings is certification as a court reporter or certification by AAERT (American Association of Electronic Reporters and Transcribers) or proof of one year of supervised mentorship with a certified court reporter or an authorized transcriptionist. Courts may require additional or different qualifications or at their discretion" **should exclude the unintentionally added words "or different" in the last sentence.** Please adopt the proposed amendment to 80(d). RAP 9.2(g) is important because the official record should be transcribed by the court reporter who was present to report it.
