Dear Justices of the Washington Supreme Court:

I write on behalf of the Latina/o Bar Association of Washington ("LBAW") in support of Proposed General Rule 36.

LBAW's purpose is to represent the concerns and goals of Latino attorneys and Latino people of the State of Washington. To that end, LBAW takes actions to promote the integrity of the judicial system and advocates for fairness and equality in the judicial system and the community at large.

After reviewing the proposed rule, our board unanimously voted to support it, and we respectfully ask that the Court adopt the rule. Although the proposed rule did not include gender as a category that would fall within the scope of the rule's protection, we believe the Court should include gender within the scope of the rule as well.

As this Court has recognized, and as we believe numerous commentators have acknowledged as well, *Batson* simply does not work. The goal of course it to not allow a person's race, or ethnicity or gender to play a part if a party is seeking to keep a person from serving on a jury. LBAW is all too aware of how both explicit, and unconscious, bias works in numerous settings against Latinas and Latinos. Those same biases are present in the courtroom and during the voir dire process. The test for preventing these biases to become part of the jury selection process must be changed. We believe proposed GR 36 (with gender added as a protected category)

accomplishes the goal protecting against both explicit, and implicit, bias coming into play during jury selection.

We strongly urge this Court to take action and adopt GR 36.
