Re: Comments on Proposed Change to RAP 10.2

Dear Ms. Carlson:

Columbia Legal Services opposes the proposed amendment to RAP 10.2 that would alter the timeline from 45 days to 30 days for filing amicus briefs.

As a civil legal aid program serving people experiencing the negative impacts of poverty and racism, Columbia Legal Services is frequently called upon to take an active role as amicus curiae in the Washington State Supreme Court and Washington Court of Appeals. Reducing the time for filing amicus briefs will negatively affect the ability of Columbia Legal Services to continue to serve in this role in three important ways.

First, amicus participation depends largely on outreach from the parties, which often occurs late in the process. Second, Columbia Legal Services usually drafts amicus briefs in collaboration with other national and local civil legal aid programs and nonprofit organizations. This intense level of coordination in legal research and drafting often requires several days, especially when occurring across time zones. Even under the existing rule, is not unusual for interested programs and organizations to express interest and support, but decide not to join as amici for reasons of timing. Third, Columbia Legal Services thoroughly analyzes legal issues for potential unintended consequences within our respective client communities. Gathering community feedback and identifying potentially impacted individuals also requires additional time.



For these reasons, we would urge that the timeline for filing of *amicus* briefs remain at the current 45 days. We appreciate your time and attention.
