Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed amendments to the comments of Code of Judicial Conduct (CJC) Rule 2.3. We support the amendments to the comments of this rule that clarify the standards of conduct to which judges are held include non-discrimination on the basis of gender identity and expression. By adding "gender expression" and "gender identity" to the list of protected characteristics, we strengthen our commitment to treating everyone who enters a state courthouse with dignity and respect.
