Keeping it limited to such a narrow scope not only prevents the program from flourishing, but also denies low-income residents and communities of color an affordable option in legal matters that don't end up in court or require an expensive attorney. Everyone should have access to affordable legal services.

To quote former Chief Justice Barbara Madsen, "The elimination of the LLLT license, which was created to address access to justice across income and race, is a step backward in this critical work. It is not the time for closing the doors to justice but, instead, for opening them wider."
