The average median income for one-person households in our state is \$50,800. The cost of dissolution with children can cost \$20,000 per side. This is not affordable for most people and certainly was way beyond anything my sister could have afforded when she needed to get out of an abusive marriage and had to protect her three children.

This is only one example of where and how important the LLLT program is in our state and actually in places all across America. As more people have suffered terrible losses, joblessness, homelessness, due to the pandemic we will need even more support from the Limited License Legal Technician.

I hope you will choose to reverse the decision to sunset the LLLT program. It's the most compassionate and practical decision to make and will in the long term benefit the individuals who take advantage of the LLLT, and will benefit the State of Washington. The justice gap must be filled.
