RE: Order Number 25700-A-1391: Suggested Amendments to the Civil Rules for Courts of Limited Jurisdiction Proposed by the WSBA Court Rules and Procedures Committee

Dear Ms. Lennon:

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the suggested amendments proposed by the WSBA Court Rules and Procedures Committee to amend the Civil Rules for Courts of Limited Jurisdiction to make rule language gender neutral. We support the amendments to these rules that update the language used in court rules to be more inclusive, and to remove biased terms. As with a number of the rule changes under current consideration, we support efforts to make the legal profession more inclusive and less biased with the goal of providing justice in its truest sense for all. These proposed amendments promote inclusivity, the elimination of bias, and a respectful courtroom setting that benefits all Washingtonians. To some, these changes may seem superficial or as merely a gesture toward broader goals. We disagree with this view. The language we use reflects our values. Every time a person hears non-inclusive language in a courtroom or reads a rule with biased terms, it reinforces a perception that courts and justice are for some and not all. But each time a person hears or reads language that is inclusive, non-biased and respectful, it sends a clear message that all are welcome and all will be treated fairly and
