I support the proposed amended GR 23 because allowing more professional guardians on the Certified Professional Guardian Board would increase Board expertise; and because making meetings public will promote transparency and public confidence in the Board.

At the moment, no more than 1/3 of the CPG Board can be guardians, per the current rule GR 23. Currently only three of the 13 Board members (23%) are Guardians.
