I am writing to ask that proposed amendment to RAP 10.10 be rejected. It is concerning that there are no safeguards required, redaction or otherwise, that would prohibit a defendant from accessing, possessing, and sharing with others sensitive materials or private information or imagery in admitted exhibits. This material could include autopsy photos, child interviews, depictions of minors engaged in sexually explicit activity, banking records, driver's licenses and other means of identification, medical records, mental health and counseling records, and videos of crime scenes.
