Re: Proposed Amendment to RAP 16.8

Dear Rules Committee:

I write in support of the proposed amendment to RAP 16.8. As Ms. Vomacka, (the drafter of the amendment) states, the practice of charging a criminal defendant filing fee for a case he or she did not file in or transfer to the appellate court is unfair.

And, many of those filing CrR 7.8 motions in the trial court are indigent and in-custody. The indigent defendant may seek a waiver of the filing but that process wastes valuable time and resources in the Court of Appeals. It likely costs more for the Clerk to administer the attempted collection of filing fees from indigent defendants than the Court actually recovers.

This Court should bring the rule into conformity with those other proceedings where the filing fee for litigation transferred to the appellate court is waived.
