I am writing this letter in response to the proposed changes to RAP 9.6 DESIGNATION OF CLERKS PAPERS AND EXHIBITS.

In reading the comments, it is clear there is a lack of understanding of how exhibits are handled. At least one comment states that the concern of copying a USB or CD that was presented as an exhibit is unfounded. The commentator states that there was not a concern when the item was played in court. This is a complete lack of understanding of how these items are played in court. These are typically played on a computer that either prosecution or defense brings to court with them and is not connected to the county network.

This rule change would require additional resources that would have to be provided by the county at county expense. The amount of work, additional expense, extensive equipment and staff time this rule change would require is great cause for concern. The lack of understanding and communication is disappointing and some of the comments are offensive and lack accuracy.

Trial counsel already has all the discovery, including copies of any exhibits and are required to assist appellant counsel.

The proposed changes to RAP 9.6 are complex and bring many challenges in how to implement the proposed changes.
