Re: Proposed Changes to RPC 6.1

The Superior Court Judges' Association's (SCJA) Civil Law and Rules Committee, Criminal Law and Rules Committee, Equality and Fairness Committee, and Family and Juvenile Law Committee reviewed the proposed changes to Rule of Professional Conduct (RPC) 6.1.

This proposed rule change will broaden the definition of pro bono publico service to encompass a lawyer's provision of court-appointed representation to those individuals entitled to an attorney at public expense. This simple change will provide additional encouragement to private attorneys to provide more public defense services. While the SCJA agrees with the proponents of the proposed rule change that these amendments will not have any significant impact on Washington's current public defense concerns, every small gesture helps. The SCJA supports the proposed changes to RPC 6.1.
