- 3. Purpose of Proposed Rule Amendment: Align infraction numbering and penalties with updates from SHB 1325, which amends RCW 77.15.160, and subsequently impacts the penalty schedule under IRLJ 6.2(d)(5).

Changes Made?

Added new violations to IRLJ 6.2(d)(5) from SHB 1325 (2025 session), added base penalty amounts for the new violations, and updated existing penalty amounts within the rule to align with legislative changes to RCW 77.15.160.

Is Expedited Consideration Requested?

Yes. SHB 1325 goes into effect July 27, 2025, and resulted in new or updated RCW violation codes. As such, almost all existing penalties have to be restated to align the numbering in the court rule with statute.

4. Is a Public Hearing Recommended? No. The substantive legal changes are required by statute.
