The court finds that the defendant has been charged with, arrested for, or convicted of a sex offense as defined in RCW 9.94A.030, a violation of RCW 9A.44.096, a violation of RCW 9.68A.090, or a gross misdemeanor that is, under chapter 9A.28 RCW, a criminal attempt, criminal solicitation, or criminal conspiracy to commit an offense that is classified as a sex offense under RCW 9.94A.030. 2. This Sexual Assault Protection Order is entered pursuant to RCW 7.90.150. This order protects:

**Warnings: Violation of this order is a criminal offense under chapter 26.50 RCW and will subject a violator to arrest. You can be arrested even if any person protected by the order invites or allows you to violate the order's prohibitions. You have the sole responsibility to avoid or refrain from violating the order's provisions. Only the court can change the order.**

**(Pretrial) It is Further Ordered:**

- Defendant is **prohibited** from accessing, obtaining or possessing a firearm, other dangerous weapon, or concealed pistol license.
- The defendant shall immediately surrender all firearms and other dangerous weapons within the defendant's possession or control, and any concealed pistol licenses, to the local law enforcement agency: \_\_\_\_\_.

These pretrial orders are based on the court's finding that possession of a firearm or other dangerous weapon by the defendant presents a serious and imminent threat to public health or safety, or to the health or safety of any individual. RCW 9.41.800(5).

Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2265, a court in any of the 50 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, any United States territory, and any tribal land within the United States, shall accord full faith and credit to the order. Federal penalties may apply.
