RE: Summary of Changes for Surrender of Weapons Forms (July 2025)

The table below outlines changes to the Surrender of Weapons forms based on chapter 7.105 RCW and comments.

	Form	Summary
1.	WS 002 Order Finding Compliance	Changes: (1) In section 8, first checkbox, added “at the hearing, in person or remotely, and received notice of the order. No further service is required (May apply even if the restrained person left before a final ruling is issued or signed.)” and removed “Additional service is not required.” based on comment and consistent with RCW 7.105.105 (4). (2) In footer, updated publication date.
2.	WS 003 Order Finding Noncompliance – Weapons/Firearms Surrender	Changes: (1) In section 3, added protected person’s lawyer based on comment. (2) In section 9, first checkbox, added “appeared at the hearing, in person or remotely, and received notice of the order. No further service is required (May apply even if the restrained person left before a final ruling is issued or signed.)” and removed “Additional service is not required.” based on comment and consistent with RCW 7.105.105 (4). (3) In footer, updated publication date.
3.	WS 600 Motion and Declaration for Order to Release Weapons	Changes: (1) In caption, added “MTAF Petitioner, MTRWR Respondent or Defendant.” (2) In first sentence, added “(check one)” for clarity. (3) Above certification language, added “I understand that law enforcement is required to conduct a background check before releasing any firearms or concealed pistol licenses. If there are other restrictions, those items will not be released.” consistent with RCW 9.41.113 . (4) In footer, updated publication date.
