Form Changes related to legislation, comments, or case law.

1.	CrR 4.2 Statement of Defendant on Plea of Guilty (Sex and non - sex)	<u>Added:</u> “The prosecuting attorney will make the following recommendation to the judge, <u>the recommendation is [] agreed [] not agreed:</u>”. <u>Changed:</u> Firearm section 6(m) to reflect changes to RCW 9A.41.041(3): I may not possess, own, or have under my control any firearm, and under federal law any firearm or ammunition, unless my firearm rights are right to do so is restored by the court in which I am convicted or the superior court in Washington State where I live, and by a federal court if required. I must immediately surrender any concealed pistol license. <u>Added:</u> If I am pleading guilty to a crime as the result of being arrested for a violation of a trafficking crime under RCW 9A.40.100, including any charge reduced from such a trafficking offense as part of a plea bargain, the court will impose a \$10,000 fine, up to 2/3 of which may be waived if I am found indigent. 2.	JuCR 7.7 Statement on Plea of Guilty	<u>Changed:</u> (1) In caption, added “Case” before “No.” and “Clerk Code:” before code. (2) In section 12, edited first sentence to read: “If any of the following paragraphs apply, the box should be checked and the paragraph initialed by the respondent.” (3) Throughout section 12, added checkboxes and lines before each paragraph requiring selection. (4) In 12(G), added “or (4) the following misdemeanor or gross misdemeanor crime(s) committed on or after July 23, 2023: domestic violence (RCW 10.99.020); stalking; cyberstalking; cyber harassment, excluding when committed solely pursuant to the element set forth in RCW 9A.90.120(1)(a)(i);

		harassment; aiming or discharging a firearm (RCW 9.41.230); unlawful carrying or handling of a firearm 2 (RCW 9.41.270); animal cruelty in the second degree committed under RCW 16.52.207(1); or, any “prior offense” involving impaired driving as defined in RCW 46.61.5055(14) if committed within 7 years of a conviction for any other prior offense for impaired driving under RCW 46.61.5055; or (5) a violation of the provisions of an order to surrender and prohibit weapons, an extreme risk protection order, or the provisions of any other protection order or no-contact order restraining the person or excluding the person from a residence, committed on or after, July 23, 2023”; and edited last sentence to “unless my firearm rights are restored by the court in which I am adjudicated and by a federal court if required”. (5) In section 15, added “and the defense attorney”. (6) In footer, updated publication date.
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
