


DETENTION ALTERNATIVE PROGRAMS

1. Detention alternative programs are tracked by assigning a youth to a detention bed defined as an alternative program.
2. Detention alternative codes are statewide codes, but each facility can decide what programs to activate for their court.
3. Types of detention alternative codes:
 - 3.1. Detention Alternative Programs (Bed/Program Assignment)
 - 3.2. Detention Alternative Tracking Events
 - 3.3. Detention Alternative End Statuses
4. Each detention facility needs to notify AOC of the programs they want to use. Alternative tracking events are set statewide.
5. Only one program can be open at a time for a juvenile.

DETENTION ALTERNATIVE PROGRAMS (Detention Bed/Program Assignment)		
24H	Community Detention – 24 Hour	24 hour community based monitoring program (e.g., house arrest or house arrest, school program, or work program).
AEM	Community Detention – Electronic Monitoring	24 hour community based monitoring program with enhanced supervision via a technology product (e.g., Electric Home Monitoring (ankle bracelet), Voice Verification System, or Global Positioning System).
ACH	Community Detention - Scheduled	Scheduled community based monitoring program (e.g., limited house arrest, school, work, day, evening, weekends)
ANP	Community Service – Non-Profit	Community service work supervised and with non-profit agency.
AGC	Group Care	Out-of-home placement in a non-secure court operated or sanctioned community detention facility.
AIP	Treatment – In-Patient	Admission in an in-patient treatment facility in lieu of court ordered detention.
AWC	Work Crew	Supervised or approved community service/restitution work program.
AOT	Other	Other alternative programs.
DETENTION ALTERNATIVE TRACKING EVENTS (Optional)		
CSV	Community Service	Community service not defined as restitution.
CSR	Community Service – Restitution	Community service defined as restitution.
DRU	Drug Detection	Drug detection (i.e. patch or urinalysis testing).
ALC	Alcohol Detection	Alcohol detection (i.e. electronic monitoring equipment or urinalysis texting).
BRC	Electronic – Bracelet	Electronic monitoring with the use of a wrist or ankle bracelet.
GPS	Electronic – Global Positioning	Electronic monitoring with the use of global positioning.
VID	Electronic – Video Verification	Electronic monitoring with video verification.
VOI	Electronic – Voice Verification	Electronic monitoring with the use of voice verification.
BOY	Gender – Boys Program	Program restricted to boys only.
GIR	Gender – Girls Program	Program restricted to girls only.
DAY	Schedule – Day Reporting	Program schedule during the daytime hours (i.e., day reporting).
EVE	Schedule – Evening Reporting	Program schedule during the evening hours.
WKN	Schedule – Weekend Reporting	Program schedule restricted to weekends.
HOM	Schedule – Home	Program schedule restricted to confined at home or residence (i.e., house arrest or limited house arrest)
SCL	Schedule – School	Program schedule restricted to school program.
WRK	Schedule – Work	Program schedule restricted to work.
NSC	Supervision – Non-secure	Supervision of program in a non-secure facility/location.
SEC	Supervision – Secure	Supervision of program in a secure facility/location.
SUP	Supervision – Supervised	Supervision of program is directly supervised by a person at all times.
SSC	Supervision – Supervision Partial	Supervision at scheduled and unscheduled times.
UNU	Supervision – Unsupervised	Supervision of program is not directly supervised by a person.
ALD	Treatment/Education – Alcohol/Drug	Nature of program is alcohol/drug treatment or education
SEX	Treatment/Education – Sexual Deviancy	Nature of program is sexual deviancy treatment or education
DETENTION ALTERNATIVE END STATUSES		
CMP	Completed	Detention time ordered is complete
CPP	Completion Partial	Partial completion of ordered program.
DET	Detained	Detained to completed time in custody.
ESC	Escape	Youth escapes while being directly supervised.
FAI	Failure	Program rules violation (e.g., whereabouts unknown, inappropriate behavior, unexcused absences)
OUT	Time Out	Youth is temporary placed into secure confinement
XFR	Transfer	Youth is moved to another detention alternative program
WRT	Warrant	Warrant issued for failure to comply with program.
