<p><b>IN THE MATTER OF EMERGENCY RESPONSE TO STATEWIDE SYSTEM OUTAGE FROM ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS</b></p>	<p align="center"><b>ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER</b></p> <p align="center"><b>2024-01</b></p>

**WHEREAS**, the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) notified affected courts statewide on November 3, 2024 that a database system breach occurred within the judicial information systems managed by AOC and required a shutdown of all judicial information systems to isolate the threat and rebuild the system; and

**WHEREAS**, this shutdown affects all aspects of the court’s processes and has created an emergency to which the Supreme Court issued Order No. 25700-B-720 in response; and

**WHEREAS**, this order incorporated by reference, grants authority to local courts to administer their courts in response to this emergency, including authority to adopt, modify, and suspend court rules and orders as warranted to address emergency conditions;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

All criminal rules regarding time for case filing, speedy trial and sentencing and infraction rules regarding time for case filing, speedy hearing and disposition are hereby suspended until AOC judicial information systems are restored.

All court rules, policies, procedures and statutes regarding filing, scheduling, docketing and transmitting information are hereby suspended until AOC judicial information systems are restored.

All court rules, policies, procedures and statutes regarding the posting of payments are suspended and any payments received shall not be processed until AOC judicial information systems are restored.
