WHEREAS, the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) identified unauthorized activity within its computer network and has taken active efforts to isolate AOC provided services resulting in state-wide unavailability of AOC systems including JIS, JABS, ETP/Sector, and the AOC maintained website as of Sunday, November 3, 2024, and

WHEREAS, the loss of the judicial information systems at AOC affects all aspects of the Court's processes and has created an emergency requiring Monroe Municipal Court to operate in a limited capacity, and

WHEREAS, there is currently no expected time for restoration of services from AOC;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. All court rules, policies, procedures, and statutes regarding filing, scheduling, docketing, and transmitting information are suspended until the AOC judicial information systems are restored.
- 2. All court rules, policies, procedures, and statutes regarding the posting of payments are suspended until the AOC judicial information systems are restored.
- 3. All time requirements of CrRLJ 3.3, CrRLJ 4.1, CrRLJ 4.7, IRLJ 2.1, IRLJ 2.6 and any other court rule, policy, procedure, or statute regarding "time" will be suspended until the AOC judicial information systems are restored.
- 4. The Court finds good cause to waive the right of speedy sentencing in cases involving a plea of guilty to a crime involving Domestic Violence, Driving Under the Influence, Physical Control of a Motor Vehicle while Under the Influence, and Driving While License Suspended in the First Degree due to the inability of the Court to verify the criminal history of the Defendant.
