**THIS ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER** is being issued in response to the status of the AOC emergency shutdown of all Statewide Court Computer systems due to a breach of the system.

This shutdown has left the local Court without the ability to look at criminal history, warrant history, Department of Licensing, docket entries, sector, or converse in any way the State Court. The Shelton Municipal Court relies on said system to determine conditions of release, sentencings, accepting payments on Court fees, and many other essential tasks as required by Court rule and the constitution.

## WHEREAS:

The Municipal Court having adopted SHMGR 37 allowing local emergency procedures;

## NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED:

The Court finds good cause to extend jurisdiction on a case by case basis as needed to fairly adjudicate matters before the court.

Sentencings will not occur until the State system is restored in most cases.

Arraignments will continue as scheduled.

Criminal and Civil matters will be reset as they come on the calendar in most cases.

Payments shall not be processed until the State system is restored.
