WHEREAS, on November 3, 2024, the Washington State Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) notified courts in the State of Washington that due to unauthorized activity on the state courts network AOC took action to secure systems which resulted in the state's Judicial Information Systems (JIS), Washington Courts websites, networks and databases being unavailable. These systems are essential to District Court Operations; and

WHEREAS, on November 8, 2024, the Washington State Supreme Court adopted Order No. 25700- B-720 granting emergency authority to this court to adopt, modify, and suspend court rules and orders as warranted to address the emergency conditions;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to said Supreme Court Order and the necessity to extend certain rules and deadlines to properly continue court functions,

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Under IRLJ 2.2(d) filing of Notice of Infraction shall be extended to 14 days from the date of this order or 14 days from the date of restoration of AOC JIS, whichever is later.
- 2. Time for hearing under IRLJ 2.6 is extended an additional 30 days from current deadline on all infractions scheduled for hearing or filed during this emergency, November 3, 2024, through date of restoration of AOC network services.
- 3. Good cause exists under CrRLJ 4.1 to extend out of custody arraignments. Time requirements under CrRLJ 3.3 and CrRLJ 4.1 are extended 14 days from the date of this order or 14 days from the date of restoration of AOC JIS, whichever is later.
