WHEREAS, the Administrative Office of the Courts identified unauthorized activity within their computer network and has taken active efforts to isolate AOC-provided services resulting in state-wide unavailability of AOC systems including JIS, JABS, ETP/Sector and the AOC website as of Monday, November 4, 2024, and

WHEREAS, there is currently no expected time for full restoration of services from AOC;

WHEREAS, once services are restored there is a need for the courts to update the information within the databases to ensure that current information is displayed.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. All filing of civil cases <u>excluding</u> petitions for protection orders, traffic infractions and petitions for judicial review of impounds or dangerous animal impounds shall be suspended through Friday, November 29, 2024.
- 2. Pursuant to IRLI 2.2(d) the court finds good cause to extend the time limits for filing of infractions issued during the state-wide unavailability of ETP/Sector and JIS beyond the five days of issuance of the notice through November 29, 2024.
- 3. The Court finds good cause to waive the right of speedy sentencing in cases involving a plea of guilty to a crime involving Domestic Violence, Driving Under the Influence, Physical Control of a Motor Vehicle while Under the Influence and Driving While License Suspended in the First Degree due to the inability of the Court to verify the criminal history of the Defendant. Sentencings for these crimes may be set outside of 14 days from entry of the plea.
- 3. This order will be reviewed no later than November 27, 2024.
