PER CURIAM. Cory Hubbard appeals his conviction for residential burglary, arguing that the trial court erred in instructing the jury that it had a "duty to return a verdict of guilty" if it found all the elements of the offense beyond a reasonable doubt. This argument is controlled by our decision in <u>State v. Ryan P. Moore</u>, No. 69766-8-I (Wash. February 18, 2014) and the cases cited therein.
