PER CURIAM. Appellant Copiers Northwest, Inc. and respondent Gifford Silver have agreed and stipulated that the trial court orders denying a motion for a change of judge and vacating default should be reversed without prejudice for Gifford to re-note a motion to vacate default before a different judge. The parties also stipulate that costs of \$490 should be awarded to Copiers Northwest. We accept the parties' stipulation. The trial court orders denying a motion for a change of judge and vacating default are reversed, and the matter is remanded to the trial court before a different trial judge for further proceedings without prejudice for Gifford to re-note a motion to vacate default. 2916 HAY Costs of \$490 are awarded to Copiers Northwest. Silver should pay the amount.
