GOALS

- Issues identified for technology improvement:
 - **Video connectivity for hybrid court hearings (Zoom, Teams, etc.)**
 - Add video system in the room to include 4 camera angles (Witness stand, counsel tables, lectern. Ability to switch camera angles on the fly, using touchscreen at clerk's station, to accommodate different hearing types. Connect to Zoom, and Teams without an expensive CODEC
 - **Sound reinforcement in the room**
 - Add gooseneck microphones, audio digital sound processor, amplifier and acoustical material
 - **Evidence sharing during hearings/trials**
 - Installation of 12-24" monitors to allow participants at counsel tables, lectern to directly connect to the courtroom monitors via HDMI cables or, wireless, and share evidence to the jury and courtroom in a more accessible manner
 - Installation of one 85" monitor for the gallery to view
 - Installation of a permanently mounted document camera to make presentation of case materials more accessible and flexible for all participants
