


Cumulative Effect of Disproportionality






What is a Relative Rate Index (RRI)?




Black youth **almost twice as likely** to be arrested




Black and American Indian youth are more than 2X more likely to be referred to court




Minority youth **less likely** to receive diversion




Minorities more likely to have petition filed

Overlap Among Delinquency, Truancy, and Dependency


Differences in Overlap by Race & Ethnicity

(Born 1990-1992; Total = 83,505 juveniles)


Total Juveniles Referred on Criminal Matter* = 59,243
